



Crawford Village and Pimbo Lane playing fields Booking policy

We are a community facility run by the charity Crawford village and Pimbo Lane playing fields association, charity number 521339. The charities constitution places upon the committee the responsibility that the building and field are *“to be held upon trust for a recreation ground for the inhabitants of Upholland and inhabitants of adjoining parishes, without distinction of sex or political or religion or other opinions and with the object of improving the conditions of life for the said inhabitants”*.

Charges for hire of the building:

Commercial hire: £10 per hour or £100 per 24 hrs

Non commercial Hire: £5 per hour or £50 per 24 hours

AM, PM or evening parties £10 per hour (incl 30 mins set up start and finish time)

We want to encourage new regular users and understand it can be hard to set up new groups, as such we offer 2 sessions free, and 2 session at ½ the usual rate.

Hire of the Field:

We do not charge for use of outdoor play facilities. We expect users to respect the facilities and remember that it is not public land but owned and managed by the charity.

Generally we do not charge for use solely of the field but require that users book the facility, to ensure it is suitable and available for use at that time. For exceptional events, including weddings, sports tournaments or other large-scale events please contact the booking secretary who will discuss your requirements and confirm charges.

As a community facility we are respectful of the community around the Hall and field. Within our booking conditions we ask that

- Users book via the website www.crawfordvillage.uk/bookings-availability
- Users pay for events via bank transfer at the above rates in advance of use
- Users agree to the terms of the booking conditions.
- All bookings are to go via the booking secretary, who may seek additional advice from the officers of the charity if they have questions over the interpretation of the policy or a booking.

This policy will be reviewed annually at the AGM and published on the website.
